

Applications for the entrance examination to the vocational school are valid from now until March 30, 2025!

Vocational training/stage dance

Vocational training as a stage dancer comprises nine years of training and begins in year 5.

A later entry into the training program is possible at any time with the appropriate artistic aptitude and previous dance training. The professional qualification

entitles and enables students to work as stage dancers. See: >>> Graduates

Vocational school for stage dance

The vocational school for stage dance is a full-time vocational school. The duration of training is 3 school years (11th to 13th year) and ends with a final school examination to become a State-certified dancer. Further school-leaving qualifications may include:

The extended vocational training entrance qualification (eBBR) or the intermediate school leaving certificate (MSA).

Those who attend our in-house vocational grammar school on the basis of a grammar school recommendation obtain a general higher education entrance qualification (Abitur) at the same time. The general entrance qualification for universities of applied sciences is obtained by those who attend the vocational grammar school until the end of year 12 and then continue and complete their training at our vocational school.

Admission to the vocational school for stage dance

Admission to our vocational school for stage dance takes place in various steps.

First you must fulfill the admission requirements*, then you can apply with a video application for the artistic aptitude procedure. Finally, the selection procedure takes place in front of the school's internal examination board and the dance medical examination by our school counselor.
